

Application for Waiver of Environmental Waste Charges 2010

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

A Household may qualify for a Waiver of the **STANDING CHARGE** element of the Environmental Waste Charge if:

- The sole income of the household is a Department of Social Protection allowance or pension
- OR
- The total household earnings are exempt from income tax.

ALL HOUSEHOLDS THAT QUALIFY FOR A WAIVER MUST PAY FOR EACH GREY AND BROWN WHEELED BIN LIFT FROM 1ST JANUARY 2010.

A Waiver Application must be made in the year to which the charge applies. Applications are assessed on the information submitted. Please note the following;

A Waiver is decided on the total household income i.e. each person over the age of 18 will be assessed and must submit proof of any income, Social Welfare payment or evidence that they are in full time education.

Proof of income **MUST** include one of the following for each adult at the address:

- A copy P60 or a P21 in the case of employment
- Evidence of payment from the Department of Social Protection (a receipt of payment or a letter from the Department).
- If in full time education, a letter from the educational institute in question is required to confirm that the named person is in full time education.

If a person has left the residence and is still listed as living at the address on the Electoral Register, a utility bill with his or her new address is required. Failure to submit the necessary supporting documentation in respect of each person listed as resident will result in the waiver application being rejected and a new application will need to be made.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please note that your waste charges are made up of 2 elements;

1. The annual Standing Charge of €96.00 for a large bin, or € 78 for a small bin

PLUS

2. A separate charge for every time your bin is emptied.

With effect from 1st January 2010, the only part that will be waived for successful applicants is the annual Standing Charge. Every customer will have to pay for every bin lift from 1st January 2010.
