WAI VER OF WASTE CHARGES 2011 GUIDANCE NOTES

Households in receipt of a waiver will receive free bags in installments up to the value of €80.00 for the year.

The Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council's waste charges waiver scheme is means tested, based on income and is not age related. If the sole income of the household is one of the following then the household will qualify for a waste charges waiver in 2011: -

- Contributory or Non-Contributory Old Age or Widows Pension, Invalidity Pension, Unemployment Assistance, Blind Persons Pension, or any similar form of Social Welfare Assistance or income.

NOTES

1. A waste charges waiver application must be submitted every year or as the Council decides.
2. If the waste charges waiver form is not completed in full, it will be returned to you.
3. Income, is income after deductions for P.A.Y.E. and P.R.S.I.. Income should truly reflect the annual level of income including, where applicable, overtime earnings.
4. Other income includes: Private Pension, Income from Rentals, etc. Please indicate if this other income is weekly or monthly.
5. Evidence of income i.e. (P60, pension book, social welfare book/statement) must be provided for each person
6. It is not necessary to have the waste charges waiver form stamped by Social Welfare. However, if further information on your Social Welfare payments is required, you may be requested to forward a Certificate of Payments from the Department of Social Protection.
7. If your consent is not forthcoming to the Declaration at Section B overleaf, please submit documentary evidence of your income and family circumstances.
8. Individuals over 18 years of age in full time education must supply a letter of confirmation from the College/University.
9. If Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council requires clarification, you will be contacted.
