WHY REUSE/RECYCLE FURNITURE?

Many unwanted items of furniture are often thrown out before the end of their useful life and usually end up in landfill or are “fly tipped”.

The Environmental Protection Agency estimate that the current remaining landfill capacity in Ireland is 8 years.

However many pieces of furniture may only have a small fault, such as a wonky leg or damaged surface, and with some care and repair would be suitable for REUSE.



WHAT WE DO

As a recycling initiative our aim is to show that furniture can be reused and restored rather than being sent for disposal in landfill or dumped illegally. Added value for the community is also created through employment and training opportunities.

Collection and delivery

Collection and/or delivery of goods in Ballymun, Finglas and Santry (Dublin North area).

Furniture restoration/woodwork services

Repair of structures, table tops, upholstery, finishing. Please note that not all furniture is suitable for restoration or recycling and we may not be able to receive some items.
