

WHAT CAN I LEAVE OUT FOR COLLECTION?

The following items will be accepted in the "Skip Bag"

1.	Household Furniture
2.	Carpets
3.	Bedding & Mattresses
4.	Kitchen units / worktops / kitchen sinks / ironing boards
5.	Doors
6.	Bathroom & Toilet Suites
7.	Bicycles
8.	Ladders
9.	Garden Furniture (including barbecues)
10.	Oil tanks, boilers and radiators (fully drained)
11.	Children's swings or slides
12.	Children's buggies, prams or other large toys

WHAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED?

The purpose of this service is to collect waste that is bulky in nature and cannot be collected in the scheduled weekly collection service. The following items will not be collected.

a.	Waste that is suitable for the grey / green bin
b.	Garden waste or waste arising from the removal or landscaping of gardens
c.	Demolition or builder's rubble i.e. soil, stones, concrete, tarmacadam, paving, plasterboard, asbestos or galvanised sheeting
d.	Large amounts of waste arising from refurbishment of houses or gardens
e.	Glass
f.	Gas cylinders (empty or full)
g.	Electrical and Electronic Goods. These may be returned to retailers when purchasing a replacement item. Alternatively they may be disposed of free of charge at the Recycling Centres located in Ringsend, Dublin 4 and North Strand, Dublin 3
h.	Household Priority Wastes such as. paints, solvents, thinners, batteries, fluorescent tubes, etc. These wastes, which require special treatment, can also be disposed of at the Recycling Centres and some Bring Centres. Details of the locations of these centres is available at www.dublinwaste.ie

NEW BULKY HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE





Waste Management Services will introduce a new household bulky waste collection service in the North Central Area and South East Area from January 2007. This new service will collect bulky household waste (furniture, kitchen units, old bicycles, radiators etc.) at your doorstep.

How to Order a Skip Bag

1. Simply telephone or call into our Customer Services Centre, Block 3, Ground Floor, Civic Offices (222 1000) to arrange payment (by cash, cheque or credit card) and a *Skip Bag* will be delivered to your door.
2. When you have filled the bag, please telephone 222 1000 to arrange a collection. Filled bags will be collected within 3 working days.

The new Household Skip Service will be available from January 1st, 2007 at a cost of **€75**, which includes the provision of the *Skip Bag*, collection and disposal by Waste Management Services.

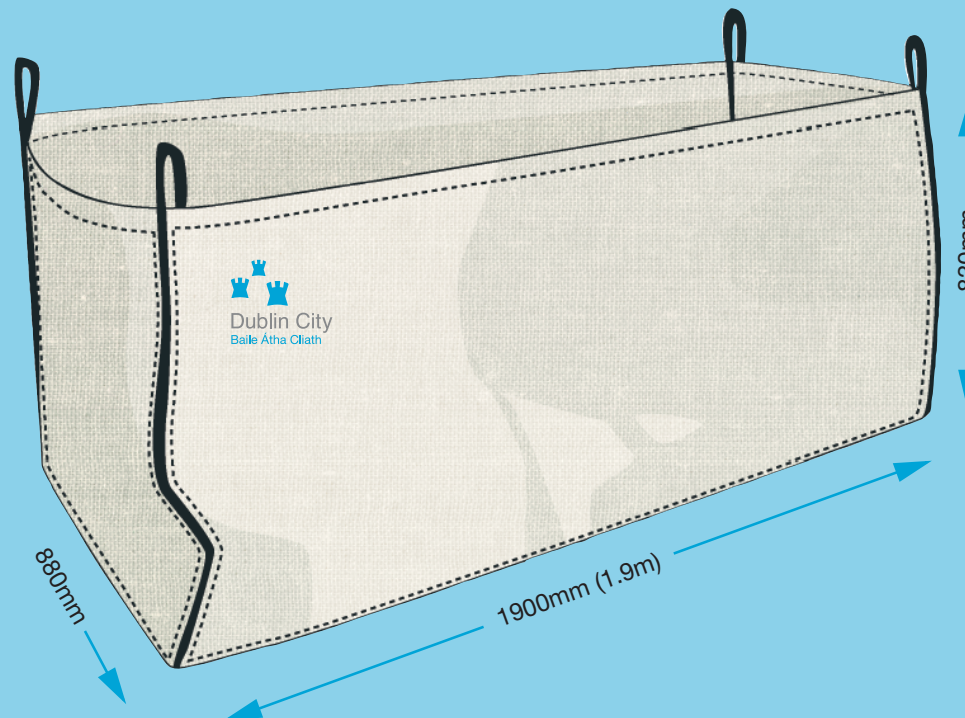
Important Information:

1. The *Skip Bag* is not reusable and the bag and its contents will be removed for disposal/recycling.
2. The *Skip Bag* should be placed inside your property and accessible for our collection vehicles

3. If the *Skip Bag* cannot be accessed by the collection vehicle it will not be removed
4. Do not overfill the bag
5. Do not place the bag near any overhead wires
6. Do not place any hazardous materials in the bag i.e., asbestos, gas cylinders, food waste, garden waste, electrical goods, or demolition waste
7. Do not place the *Skip Bag* on a public footpath or roadway.

8. The *Skip Bag* will only be collected from the address given at the time of purchase
9. Dublin City Council reserves the right to remove any items left for collection that is not on the designated list or is hazardous

Dublin City Council will not accept any liability for loss or damage to property and householders are reminded that they are responsible for the Skip Bag and its contents pending removal by Dublin City Council.
